

## Progress Conversations

Parents, please note that our teaching-staff will be meeting shortly to discuss a socially distanced and practical way to meet with you in late October/Early November. This term one conversation is to get to know families, share initial assessment findings, and communicate learning intentions for the year. We will be contacting you mid-month to schedule a time and share the format.

### Thoughts to consider before the meeting:

1. What strengths your child has as a learner. This can include academic and other strengths outside of school such as sports, the arts, etc.
2. Make goals that you think would helpful for your child in their day to day life. Do they need to be able to pay for things at the store? Do they have difficulty reading books to their siblings?
3. Think about what good work habits your child has at school or at home. For instance, does he/she stick to a job until it is completed? Do they get right down to work?
4. Think about how your child gets along with others and any concerns/worries they may have about school.
